### THE SCHOOL CURRICULUM

Guidelines for the St. Gregory School curriculum are implemented according to the Archdiocese of San Francisco Administrative Handbook and California State Standards. The curriculum is carefully coordinated from kindergarten through eighth grade. Teachers review and evaluate textbooks cyclically in specified curriculum areas. The curriculum includes: religion and family life, language arts (spelling, grammar, writing, handwriting), mathematics, literature, science (health and drug education), social studies, computer and technology education, art, music, drama, library skills, physical education and study skills. Additional classes in music, foreign language and science are available in after-school programs.
