### **Summer Mathletics Requirements**

#### **Live Mathletics**

*Complete Live Mathletics Questions*

Incoming 1<sup>st</sup> Grade: 500 Q's correct at level 1

Incoming 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade: 500 Q's correct at level 2

Incoming 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade: a total of 500 Q's correct at level 2 & 3

Incoming 4<sup>th</sup> Grade: a total of 500 Q's correct at level 3 & 4

Incoming 5<sup>th</sup> Grade: a total of 500 Q's correct at level 4

Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade: 1,000 Q's correct at level 4

Incoming 7<sup>th</sup> Grade: a total of 1000 Q's correct at level 4 & 5

Incoming 8<sup>th</sup> Grade: a total of 1000 Q's correct at level 4 & 5

Q's Correct can be located on the left side of the Live Mathletics screen or under My Reports on the front screen of the Live Mathletics portion of the program.

#### **Workbook Pages**

The workbook pages are taken from the students' current enVisionMath workbook. Teachers have determined which topics would be good for review. Complete the workbook pages that have been assigned. These pages should be printed out and completed in pencil. We will be collecting these pages on the first day of school. ## **Frequently Asked Questions**

Q. Will my child be given credit for completing these assignments?

A. Yes, students will receive a total of 60 points towards their first quarter math grade. They will be given 30 points for Live Mathletics and 30 points for the workbook pages.

Q. What Student Center Lessons will be required?

A. There are no mandatory lessons; however, if your child struggles with math, his or her teacher has recommended lessons that will help strengthen your child's skills.

Q. My child works best when he can write answers down on paper. Can he use a notebook to work out his answers?

A. When your child is working through the lessons, it is recommended (for problems that are usually worked out with pencil and paper) that he uses a notebook or scratch paper to help him. This will not be collected by his teacher, but is still a useful tool for working out problems.

Q. Is there support for my child if she gets stuck on a problem?

A. If your child is having trouble, she can click on the question mark to enter the Support Center. She will not find the same question, but a similar question will be presented, to help her.

Q. Does my child need to view the reports?

A. Reports are important for keeping track of how she is doing. Each time she completes an activity or test, she will see a graph of her results. She can see if she has improved or if she needs more practice.

Q. How does my child receive points?

A. Achieving high scores and certificates throughout Mathletics will enable your child to gain credits to get additional accessories and styles for his character. He will earn points as he works through activities, tests, and plays Live Mathletics.

Q. Do we have to print out the certificates of achievement?

A. No, the teachers will be able to access that information online.

Q. How do I check my students' progress on Live Mathletics?

A. Sign in with your student and have them show you their progress within the Live Mathletics section.

Q. What are "Points" in Mathletics?

A. "Points" are strictly to track participation, they are not the same as Q's Correct.
